



Our Academics:

Academics are held to a high standard in our brotherhood. In Fall 2023, our chapter achieved a 3.25 GPA and our new members achieved a 3.31 GPA, placing us above the all Greek average. In Spring 2023, our chapter achieved a 3.27 GPA, placing us again above all students, all male, and all Greek GPAs and 6th among fraternities.

We require all new members to attend mandatory study hours for three hours a night on Sundays through Thursdays. Additionally, any active brothers who do not make the house standard 2.6 GPA will be put on mandatory study hours the next semester. All associates will also have a Big Brother who will hold them accountable for grades.

Our Philanthropy and Volunteering:

Every semester, all members must complete 15 hours of community service. This is not difficult due to our chapter's frequent volunteering events and philanthropic involvement on campus.

Each member must participate in our annual Chicken Benefit Dinner every fall. This is one of the most successful fraternity fundraising projects on campus. Last year we raised \$10,000 for multiple organizations such as the American Red Cross, the local Alzheimer's Association, and our national fraternity philanthropy, Feeding America.

We also host smaller philanthropy events including our Watermelon Bash and brand new Miner Memory Walk in support of the Phelps County Walk to End Alzheimer's Association. We volunteer on weekends at multiple charities and community organizations throughout each semester.
